- ✓ Increasing awareness of the issues surrounding littering, and working together through public-private collaboration, to keep our community litter-free.


Objectives

Concept



- ✓ Food, cleaning materials, and token for participants will be provided by PMFTC
- ✓ SWAPP will be in charge of the over-all waste segregation and final disposal

- ✓ Garbage truck will be deployed to retrieve biodegradable and paper collected by participants. Other necessary paraphernalia will also be provided by project partners
- ✓ Weighing area at HPA Grandstand will be designated for all hard plastics (i.e., bottles) and cigarette butts only.
- ✓ LGU Taguig to invite community to participate on the activity
